1. Call to Order and Announce a Quorum is Present

- **4.** Commissioner Supak made a motion to approve the minutes of July 11, 2017 regular meeting Commissioner Perrault seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- <u>5.</u> Commissioner Supak made a motion to approve the minutes of the July 27, 2017 special meeting. Mayor Pavlock seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- 6. Commissioner Perrault made motion to approve on request from Mr. Al Sulak for a setback variance on the corner of Illinois of five feet and Kibler of five feet. Commissioner Supak seconded. Motion passed unanimously. Mayor Pavlock abstained from voting.
- 7. Commissioner Perrault made a motion to approve the grant terms and conditions for the \$100,000.00 grant from Henderson-Wessendorff Foundation. Commissioner Supak seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- **8.** Commissioner Supak made a motion to approve payment for restroom facilities in the amount of \$1,175.00 from OIDC for the Jamboree this year. Commissioner Perrault seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- 9. Commissioner Perrault made a motion to propose the roll back tax rate for 2017 at a rate of \$0.356684 to be adopted on September 12, 2017 at the regular scheduled meeting. Commissioner Supak seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- <u>10.</u> Commissioner Supak made a motion to accept the tax collector anticipated tax collection rate of 100%. Commissioner Perrault seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

- <u>11.</u> Commissioner Perrault made a motion to approve the certification of the 2017 appraisal roll. Commissioner Supak seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- <u>12.</u> Commissioner Supak made a motion to accept proposal from J. E. Sanchez for tree trimming for the total of \$5,225.00. Commissioner Perrault seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- 13. Commissioner Perrault made a motion to approve the revised lease agreement with the intent that all of our current tenants have signed lease agreement by December 31, 2017. Commissioner Supak seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- 14. Discuss Pavilion update. We currently have \$100,000.00 from George Foundation and \$100,000.00 from Wessendorff-Henderson Foundation. We are in the process of submitting a request to the Vivian L. Smith Foundation for \$50,000.00.
