- 1. Call to Order and Announce a Quorum is Present: With a quorum of the Commissioners present, Mayor Rod Pavlock called the Regular Meeting of the Orchard City Council to order at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 9, 2021 in the Council Chambers of the Orchard City Hall, 9714 Kibler, Orchard, Texas.

- 4. Commissioner Supak made a motion to approve the minutes of February 10th, 2021 meeting. Commissioner Perreault seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
