

## Orchard City Council Regular Meeting, September 14, 2021

1. Call to Order and Announce a Quorum is Present:

With a quorum of the Commissioners present, Mayor Rod Pavlock called the Regular Meeting of the Orchard City Council to order at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, September 14, 2021 in the Council Chambers of the Orchard City Hall, 9714 Kibler, Orchard, Texas.

2. Roll Call: Rod Pavlock, Mayor Joe Supak, Commissioner Matt Perreault, Commissioner Melissa Andel, City Secretary

- 3. Public Recognition: no one present
- 4. Commissioner Perreault made a motion to approve the minutes of the August 10<sup>th</sup> 2021 regular meeting. Commissioner Supak seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Commissioner Supak made a motion to approve the minutes of the August 24<sup>th</sup> 2021 special meeting. Mayor Pavlock seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
- 5. Heather Delso and Taylor Boeker from Seidel Schroeder presented the 2020-2021 audit.
- 6. Commissioner Supak gave a short explanation of what the Orchard First Baptist Church was going to do for National Night Out on October 5<sup>th</sup> 2021.
- 7. No action was taken on changing the water and sewer rates.
- 8. Commissioner Supak made a motion to give Melissa Andel a raise. Commissioner Perreault seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
- 9. There seem to be only benefits for the city if the city annexes the property on Missouri st into the city limits that Aquavalt is on.
- 10. Commissioner Perreault made a motion to approve ordinance 129-21 to annex the property on Missouri st where the sewer plant is into the city limits. Mayor Pavlock seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Commissioner Supak abstained from voting.

- 12. Commissioner Supak made a motion for Jones and Carter to do have water / sewer outside the city limit at the land owner's expense. Commissioner Perreault seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
- 13. Commissioner Perreault made a motion to raise the rent fee to \$300.00 starting October 1st 2021 for the Community Center. Commissioner Supak seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

- 16. Commissioner Supak made a motion to approve the financial statement. Commissioner Perreault seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Supak made a motion to approve the payment of bills and transfer for the month of August in the amount of \$30,000.00: transfer of \$15,000.00 on 8/6/2021 and \$15,000.00 on 8/27/2021. Commissioner Supak abstained from check number 8006. Commissioner Perreault seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
