Regular Meeting, April 13, 2021

1. Call to Order and Announce a Quorum is Present:

With a quorum of the Commissioners present, Mayor Rod Pavlock called the Regular Meeting of the Orchard City Council to order at 5:20 p.m. on Tuesday, April 13, 2021 in the Council Chambers of the Orchard City Hall, 9714 Kibler, Orchard, Texas.

4. Commissioner Perreault made a motion to approve the minutes of March 9th, 2021 meeting. Commissioner Supak seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

11. No action taken on the budget.


12. Commissioner Supak made a motion to approve the financial statement. Commissioner Perreault seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
