- 1. Call to Order and Announce a Quorum is Present: With a quorum of the Commissioners present, Mayor Rod Pavlock called the Regular Meeting of the Orchard City Council to order at 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 9, 2021 in the Council Chambers of the Orchard City Hall, 9714 Kibler, Orchard, Texas.
