1. Call to Order and Announce a Quorum is Present:

Commissioner Wesbrooks seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Commissioner Perreault made a motion to ask EDC for \$15,000.00 for future projects that will be done (shade cells). Commissioner Wesbrooks seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

13. Commissioner Perreault made a motion to approve the May 2023 financial statements. Commissioner Wesbrooks seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
