1. Call to Order and Announce a Quorum is Present

- **4.** Commissioner Perrault made a motion to approve the minutes of October 11, 2016 regular meeting. Commissioner Supak seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
- <u>5.</u> Discussed two bids for electrical work in park. Bid from Urbish Electric is \$13,350.00 and the bid from Starbrite Electric is \$22,125.00. Commissioner Supak made a motion to approve the electrical bid from Urbish Electric for \$13,350.00 Commissioner Perrault seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
