

ORDINANCE NO. 137-25

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORCHARD, TEXAS, SETTING THE FISCAL YEAR OF THE CITY TO START THE FIRST DAY OF OCTOBER AND END THE LAST DAY OF SEPTEMBER; SUPERSEDING AND REVOKING PREVIOUS ORDINANCES RELATED TO THE SAME; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Orchard, Texas (the "City") is authorized to set an annual budget under Chapter 102 of the Local Government Code; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that a consistent fiscal year is necessary for the effective budgeting, financial planning, and accounting for the City; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council to adopt a fiscal year that aligns with common municipal, local, state, and federal practices;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORCHARD, TEXAS, THAT:

SECTION 1. The facts and matters set out in the preamble to this ordinance are found to be true and are incorporated for all purposes.

SECTION 2. The fiscal year for the City shall begin on the first day of October of each year and end on the last day of September of the succeeding calendar year.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance supersedes any prior ordinance pertaining to the same subject matter and any prior ordinances setting the fiscal year are hereby revoked.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance takes effect immediately upon adoption and execution.
