

City of Orchard, Texas Ordinance No.134-24

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING THE HEREAFTER DESCRIBED TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF ORCHARD, FORT BEND COUNTY, TEXAS, AND EXTENDING THE BOUNDARY LIMITS OF SAID CITY SO AS TO INCLUDE SAID HEREAFTER DESCRIBED PROPERTY WITHIN SAID CITY LIMITS, AND GRANTING TO ALL THE INHABITANTS OF SAID PROPETY ALL THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF OTHER CITIZENS AND BINDING SAID INHABITANTS BY ALL OF THE ACTS, ORDINANCES, RESOLUTIONS, AND REGULATIONS OF SAID CITY; AND ADOPTING A SERVICE PLAN.

WHEREAS, the owner of the territory has petitioned the City Council for the City of Orchard in writing to annex the proposed area.

WHEREAS, the procedures prescribed by the (Texas Local Government Code and/or Charter) of the City of Orchard, Texas, and the laws of this state have been duly followed with respect to the following described territory, to wit:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORCHARD, TEXAS:

That the heretofore described property is hereby annexed to the City of Orchard, Fort Bend County, Texas, and that the boundary limits of the City of Orchard be and the same are hereby extended to include the above described territory within the city limits of the City of Orchard, and the same shall hereafter be included within the territorial limits of said city, and the inhabitants thereof shall hereafter be entitled to all rights and privileges of other citizens of the city of Orchard and they shall be bound by the acts, ordinances, resolutions, and regulations of said city.

A service plan for the area is adopted and attached as exhibit B.

8.6307 Acres Fort Bend County, Texas

An 8.6307-Acre tract of land situated in the Thomas Toby Survey, Abstract 338, Fort Bend County, Texas, being the residue of Lot 18 (called Tract 2) described in a deed to Arnold P. and Betty L. Supak recorded under Fort Bend County Clerk's File Number 2003064143 of the official public records, same being out of and a part of Lot 18 as shown on the map or plat of Orchard Farms recorded in Volume 2, Page 517 of the Fort Bend County Deed Records, said 8.6307- Acre Tract being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows, (bearings based on the Texas Coordinate System of 1983, South Central Zone (4204), as determined by GPS measurements):

BEGINNING at a found ¾-inch iron pipe at the southeast intersection of the right-of-way lines of South Missouri Avenue (90-foot width) and Rosenberg Street (40-foot width, unimproved) both recorded in said Orchard Farms marking the Northwest corner of said Lot 18, and the **POINT OF BEGINNING** of the herein described tract of land;

THENCE North 87°32′25″ East, 1,170.00 feet along the south right-of-way line of said Rosenberg Street and the north line of said Lot 18 to a ½-inch iron rod set with cap stamped "RPLS 5485" marking the northwest corner of Lot 7 of said Orchard Farms and the northeast corner of said Lot 18, and of the herein described tract of land;

THENCE South 02°28′12″ East, 358.56 feet to a ½-inch iron rod set with cap stamped "RPLS 5485" at the northeast corner of the residue of Lot 19 described in a deed from Marvin G. & Vadna Lecy Olle recorded under Fort Bend County Clerk's File Number 2001082071 of the Official Public Records, the northwest corner of Lot 6 of said Orchard Farms, the southwest corner of said Lot 7, the southeast corner of said Lot 18 and of the herein described tract of land, from which a found ¾-inch iron rod bears South 61°55′ West, 2.1 feet; THENCE South 87°32′25″ West, 870.00 feet along the north line of said residue of


THENCE South 87°32′25″ West, 870.00 feet along the north line of said residue of Lot 19 and the south line of said Lot 18 to the southeast corner of a called 1.00-acre tract of land described in a deed to Eugene L. and Jo Ann Demny recorded under Fort Bend County Clerk's File Number 2010105297 of the Official Public Records and the southerly most southwest corner of the herein described tract of land, from which a found 60D nail bears South 88°32′ East, 0.4 feet;

THENCE with the east and north lines of said called 1.00-acre tract of land and said Lot 18 as follows:

North 02°28′12″ West, 145.20 feet to a found 5/8-inch iron rod with cap stamped "RPLS 1935/4035" for the northeast corner of said called 1.00-acre tract of land, and a reentrant corner of the herein described tract of land, from which a found ½-inch iron rod bears North 05°01′ West, 3.4 feet;

South 87°32′25″ West, 300.00 feet to a found 5/8-inch rod with cap (illegible) in the east right-of-way line of said South Missouri Avenue marking the northwest corner of said called 1.00-acre tract of land and a reentrant corner of the herein described tract of land;

THENCE South 02°28'12" East, 213.36 feet along the west right-of-way line of said South Missouri Avenue and the east line of the residue of said Lot 18 to the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 8.6307 acres (375,955 square feet) of land.



City of Orchard Municipal Service Plan Exhibit B

A. Police Protection

1. Services to be provided: The area is under the jurisdiction of the Fort Bend County Sheriff's office. Upon annexation, the Sheriff's Dept will continue regular service to annexed area. Policy enforcement and protection services shall be provided through regular patrols and at the request of residents.

B. Fire Protection

1. Services to be provided: Fire suppression will be available to the area upon annexation. Primary fire response will be provided by the Orchard Volunteer Fire Department located in Orchard, Texas. Fire prevention activities will be provided by the Fire Marshall's office as needed.

C. Solid Waste Collection

1. Services to be provided: Solid waste collection service shall be provided to residents in the annexed area in accordance with the existing city ordinances, resolutions and regulations, within 60 days after the effective date of the annexation of the area.

D. Water Service

1. Water services shall be provided to the annexed area in accordance with the existing city ordinances, resolutions, and regulations. Full municipal water service will be provided to the annexed area no later than 2½ years after the effective date of the annexed area. Unless certain services cannot be reasonably provided within that time and a city proposes a schedule to provide services within 4½ years.

E. Sanitary Sewer Service

1. Sanitary sewer services shall be provided to the annexed area in accordance With the existing city ordinances, resolutions, and regulations. Full municipal sanitary sewer services shall be provided to the annexed area no later than 2 ½ years after the effective date of the annexation of the area.

F. Maintenance of Roads and Streets

1. Services to be provided: Street maintenance and other street services shall be provided to the annexed area in accordance with existing city, ordinances, resolutions, and regulations after the effective date of the annexation of the area.

G. Parks and Recreation

1. Services to be provided: All of the city parks and recreational facilities shall be available for use by residents of the annexed area, beginning on the effective date of the annexation ordinance. Deposit and fees apply.

H. Street Lighting

1. Services to be provided: The city will coordinate any request for street lighting with the local electric provider in accordance with standard policy.

I. Miscellaneous

1. All other applicable municipal services will be provided to the area in accordance with the City of Orchard's established policies governing extension of municipal services to newly annexed areas.

The City Secretary is hereby directed to file with the County Clerk of Fort Bend, Texas, a certified copy of the ordinance.
