



## **ORDINANCE NO. 139-25**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ORCHARD, TEXAS, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 093-2010, REPEALING THE CURFEW FOR MINORS PROVIDING SEVERABILITY; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the Texas legislature enacted House Bill 1819, effective September 1, 2023, mandating the repeal of juvenile curfew ordinances statewide; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Orchard seeks to comply with state law and ensure its ordinances align with current legislative requirements;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORCHARD, TEXAS:**

### **SECTION 1. REPEAL**

Ordinance 09-2010, Passed and Approved on March 10, 2010, in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Orchard, entitled "ESTABLISHING CURFEW TIMES FOR MINORS, ESTABLISHING DEFINITIONS AND PUNISHMENT FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE," is hereby repealed in its entirety.


### **SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY**


