ORDINANCE NO. 109-2015

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ORCHARD, TEXAS, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 96-2011 IN IT'S ENTIRETY, WHICH ESTABLISHED RULES FOR THE REGISTRATION OF SEX OFFENDERS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Orchard, Texas (the "City"), passed, approved, and adopted Ordinance No. 96-2011 on October 12, 2011, which established rules for the registration of sex offenders; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City has found that the following regulations will not adversely affect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens and persons within the City; now therefore.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ORCHARD, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the facts and matters set forth in the preamble of this Ordinance are hereby found to be true and correct. It is the policy of the city protect, promote and preserve the public health, comfort, convenience, safety and welfare.

Section 2. Repeal. Ordinance No. 96-2011, adopted by City Council on October 12, 2011, is hereby repealed in its entirety. Any other ordinance or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such inconsistency or conflict, also hereby repealed.
