### AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE FIXING AND LEVYING A MUNICIPAL AD VALOREM TAX ON REAL PROPERTY FOR THE CITY OF ORCHARD, TEXAS, FOR THE YMAR 1979, AND FOR EACH YEAR THEREAFTER UNTIL OTHERWISE PROVIDED; DIRECTING THE ASSESSMENT AND COLLECTION THEREOF; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Orchard, Texas:

SECTION 1: For the general expenses of the City of Orchard and for the general improvement of the City and its property, there is hereby levied and ordered to be assessed and collected for the year 1979, and for each year thereafter until it be otherwise provided and ordained, on all real property situated within the limits of the City of Orchard, and not exempt from taxation by valid laws, an ad valorem tax at the rate of TWENTY-FIVE CENTS (\$0.25) on each One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) valuation of such property.

SECTION 2: WHEREAS, an emergency is apparent for the immediate preservation of order, health, safety and general welfare of the public that requires the Ordinance to become effective immediately, therefore, it shall be effective from and after the date of its passage and approval.
