BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ORCHARD, STATE OF TEXAS:

I.

That ARTICLE THREE: SEWER, Section 11, of the above captioned ORDINANCE of the 14th day of May, 1975 be amended as follows:

Sec. 11. The following monthly charges are hereby fixed to be paid by all subscribers for sewer service:

- (a) Private residences under one billing, the sum of SIX AND 50/100 DOLLARS (\$6.50) per month.
- (b) Trailer parks, apartment houses, hospitals, industrial plants, schools, office building complexes and the like in an amount to be determined by the Council.

II.

The fact that it is essential that sewer rates be accurately established in order that the citizens of the City of Orchard, Texas, may be provided with such sewer service constitutes and creates this ordinance an emergency measure being one for the preservation of the health of the citizens of the City of Orchard, Texas, and necessitating that this ordinance be adopted as an emergency measure, and it is so ordained, passed, and approved.
