

ORDINANCE # 017-792


AN ORDINANCE GIVING THE CITY OF ORCHARD FULL RIGHT AND AUTHORITY TO ENTER ANY PROPERTY AND INSPECT ANY CONNECTIONS MADE BY CUSTOMERS TO THE SYSTEM AND TO ENFORCE CORRECTING ANY FAULTY CONDITIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ORCHARD, STATE OF TEXAS:

The Orchard Water Supply hereinafter "System" reserves the full right and authority to enter upon the property of any and all of the System's customers which are served by direct pressure from the System supply for the purpose of inspecting any and all connections made by such customers to the System water lines. Should the System ascertain, or have reasonable grounds to believe that there exists any condition within said customers property which might result in contamination of System's water supply, then the System shall notify the customer and the customer shall immediately correct such condition. In the event the customer fails to correct such condition within 10 days, the System reserves the right to cease delivering water under this Contract until such condition is corrected to the satisfaction of the System.
