AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE MANUFACTURE, ASSEMBLY, STORAGE, TRANSPORTATION, RECEIPT, KEEPING, SALE, USE OR DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS OF ANY DESCRIPTION WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF ORCHARD, TEXAS; PROVIDING FOR A PERMIT AND REQUIRING A BOND; PROVIDING A PENALTY OF A FINE NOT TO EXCEED \$200.00 FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON ITS PASSAGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF ORCHARD, TEXAS:

SECTION ONE: PROHIBITED ACTS. It shall be unlawful for any person to manufacture, assemble, store, transport, receive, keep, sell, offer or have in his possession with intent to sell, use, discharge, cause to be discharged, ignite, detonate, fire or otherwise set in action any fire-crackers, Roman candles, cherry boms, TNT bombs, skyrockets, pinwheels, or aerial bombs or any fireworks of any description without proper permit from the City Council.

SECTION TWO: PERMIT. Any person who shall desire to manufacture, assemble, store, transport, receive, keep, sell, offer or have in his possession with intent to sell, use, discharge, cause to be discharged, ignite, detonate, fire or otherwise set in action any fireworks within the city limits of the City of Orchard shall make application to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Orchard in writing which application shall state the name and address of the applicant, the date and time for which the permit is desired to be issued, the specific location within the city limits of Orchard, Texas, for which the permit is desired to be issued, a complete description of the activity desired to be undertaken on the date and time and at the location specified, and a complete list of each firecracker, Roman candle, cherry bomb, TNT bomb, skyrocket, pinwheel, aerial bomb or other fireworks to be manufactured, assembled, stored, transported, received, kept, sold, used, discharged or detonated within the city limits of Orchard, Texas. The permit by the Board of Commissioners shall specify the activity in detail, the exact location, date and time when the activity shall be permitted and a complete list of the fireworks which shall be permitted to be manufactured, assembled, stored, transported, received, kept, sold, used, discharged or detonated and shall set the amount of a bond to be provided by applicant.

SECTION THREE: <u>BOND</u>. Before any permit shall be effective, the applicant therefor shall provide a bond with not less than two (2) good and sufficient sureties acceptable to the Board of Commissioners of the City of Orchard, payable to the Mayor of the City of Orchard in an amount set by the Board of Commissioners of the City of Orchard, conditioned that the principal and surety will pay all damages to persons caused by, arising from or growing out of the specifically permitted activity.

SECTION FOUR: <u>DEFINITIONS</u>. (a) "Person" is defined to include natural persons, partnerships and corporations.

(b) "Fireworks" are any contrivance of inflammable and/or explosive materials combined in various proportions for the purpose of producing in combustion beautiful or amusing or entertaining visual or auditory effects.

SECTION FIVE: <u>PENALTY</u>. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in any sum not more than \$200.00.

SECTION SIX: DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. Whereas, an emergency is apparent for the immediate preservation of order, health, safety, and the general welfare of the citizens of the City of Orchard and in order to prevent fire and other casualty to property lying within the city limits of the City of Orchard that requires this ordinance to become effective immediately, therefore, this ordinance shall be effective from and after the date of its passage and approval.


